AO Team Teaching Model



- **Integrated instructional model**
 - Pairs basic skills and CTE instructors
 - Instructors work well together
 - Contextualized content
 - Accelerated learning

Successful team teacher



- Flexibility
- Work cooperatively & interactively
- Accept new andragogy
- Assess & meet students needs
- Expect the best
- Confident

The 'arranged marriage'



- Meet instructor qualifications
- Flexible
- Effective communication skills
- Willingness to embrace new andragogy
- Confidence/willingness to give up some control in classroom
- Sensitive to the needs of adult learners

How is success (determined)?



- Formal & informal
- Within the contract
- Within the culture
