


- FY24 Perkins Leadership Grant- 18 applicants

Initiatives to Support Students

- <u>Pipeline for the Advancement of the Healthcare</u> <u>Workforce</u> (PATH)
 - <u>Purpose</u>: to support students and incumbent workers who wish to enroll in a healthcare program or upskill.
 - 2nd year
 - State grant so there is a lot of flexibility with funding and how it can be used to support students, faculty and staff, marketing/recruiting, building program capacity, etc.

Initiatives to Support Students

- Workforce Equity Initiative (WEI)
 - <u>Purpose</u>: create, support, or expand short-term workforce (credit and/or noncredit) training opportunities in high-need, minority communities focused on specific sectors with identified workforce gaps. Students receive support services to remove barriers to enrollment and completion.
 - 5th year of funding, began in FY20
 - State grant so there is a lot of flexibility with funding
 - 18 participating colleges, over 120 WEI programs
