This series is designed to support groups and individuals to increase trauma-informed practices and support learner and educator resilience in postsecondary and adult education contexts.

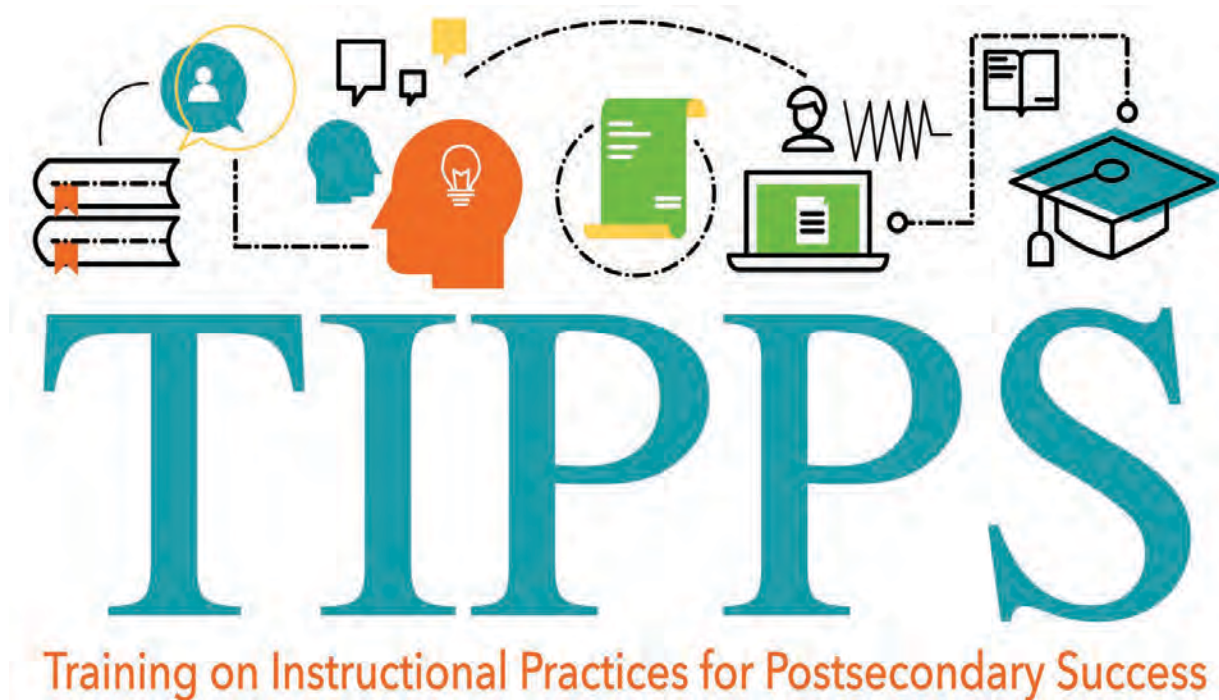
