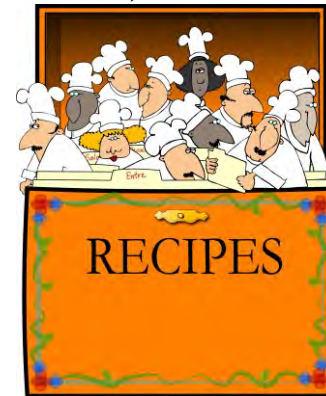

Our Dean's Recipe of Strategies

- Plan Till You Drop (use every project planning and project management tool)
 - Operational (Map the process using Visio; Use a CRM if you have the resources or a Case Management System)
 - Curriculum Development (Use Gantt chart; schedule meetings with faculty least a year in advance)
- Diversify Your Offerings
- Provide a Clear Academic Plan
- Develop Strong Partnerships
- Seek and Diversify Funding
- Use Targeted Recruitment



Team Teaching can be Magical!



Team- teaching Tips



- **Be ready to pivot as needed**
- **Network with CTE peers**
- Never take anything for granted – explicitly discuss everything.
- Decide upon unacceptable classroom behavior together (cell phones, speaking out of turn...)
- Plan all lessons together including in/out of class evaluations
- Develop a mutually agreed upon back-up plan
- Always show respect to one another both inside and outside the classroom.
