- Test is given only at official test centers

Registration

- Sign up for MyGED™
- Locate a testing center
- Register for each test separately
- Pay for each test separately using a credit/debit card or voucher from test center



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The 2014 GED Experience



Cost

- \$30 per test, totaling \$120
- \$10 per retake – can take each test up to 3 times per year
- \$10 (and proof of passing score on constitution test) to your county's ROE to receive certificate



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Content Areas

(Also called Tests or Modules)

- Reasoning Through Language Arts
- Mathematical Reasoning
- Science
- Social Studies

Results



- Test takers will receive their scores shortly after completion of module
- Scores range from 100 – 200 on each section
- Passing score: 150 on each section, 600 total score
- Honors score: 170 on each section, reflecting college and career readiness

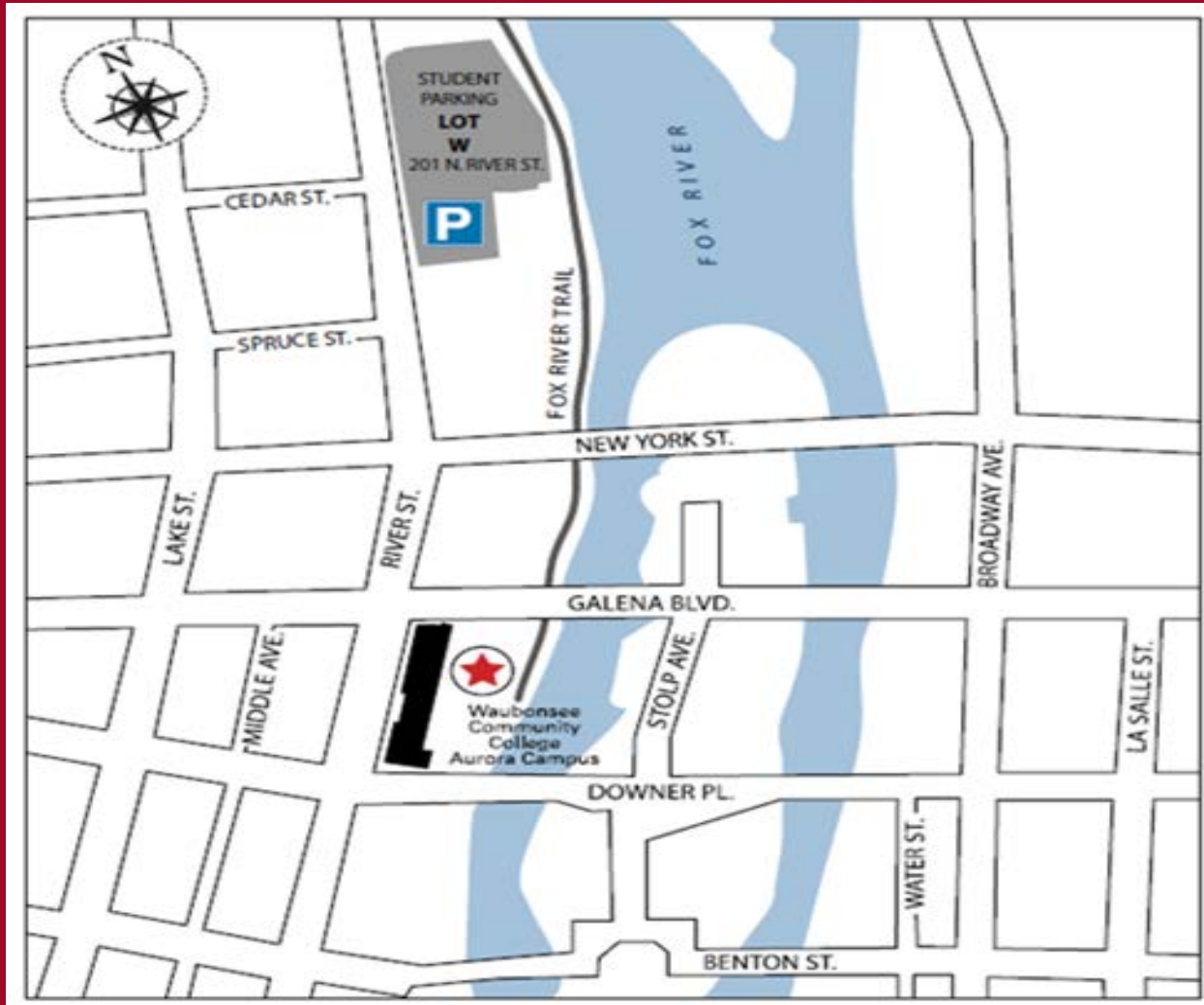


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Parking
