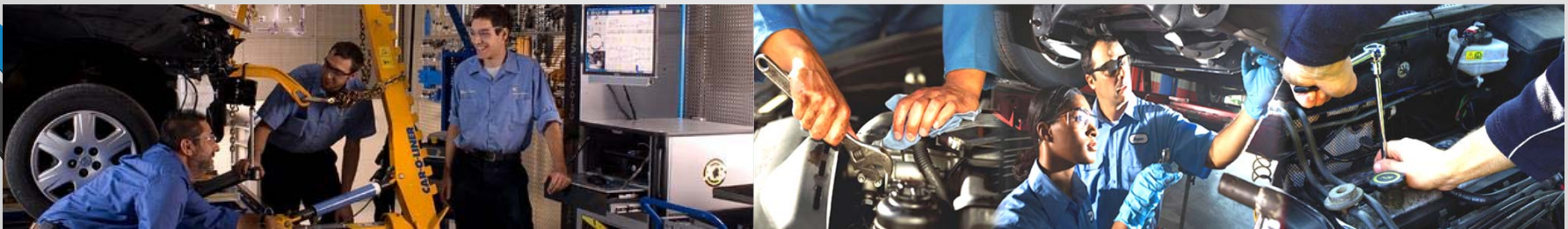

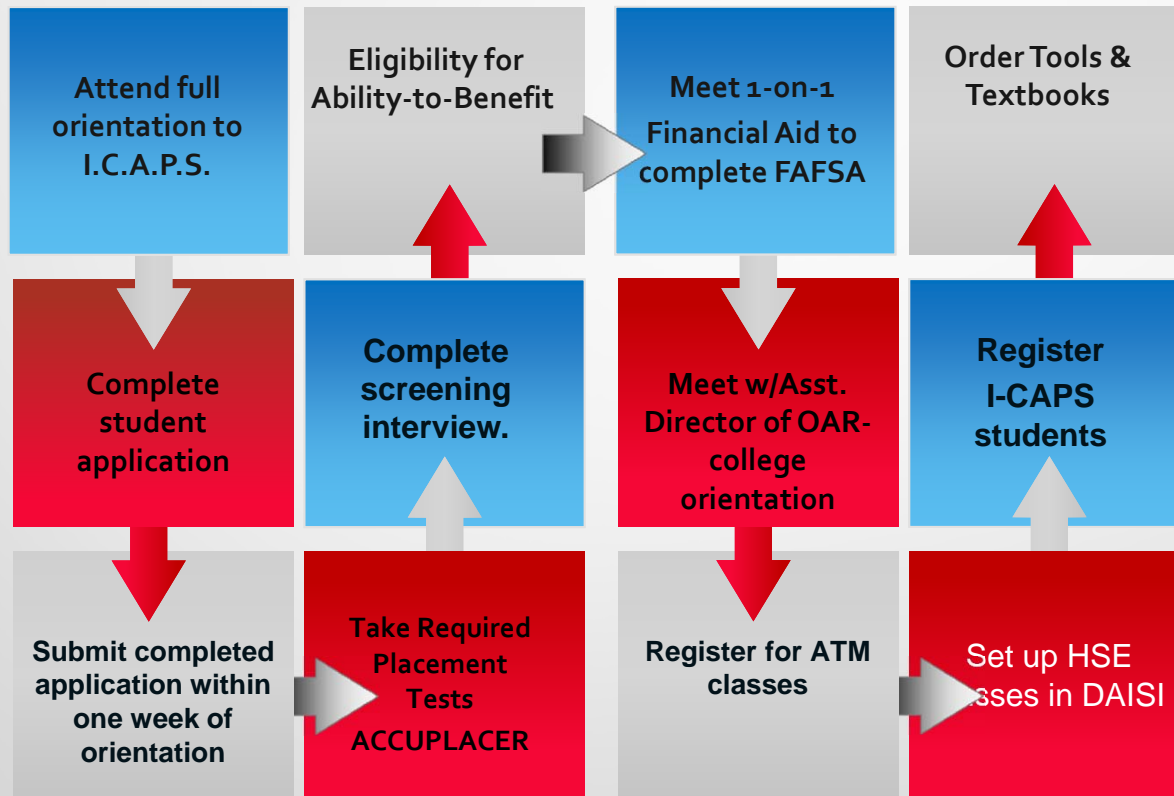
MLR 16-Credit College Certificate Benefits

Challenges

- C.T.E. ATM classes not flexible
- A.E. has to fit into college enrollment schedule
- Local WorkNet Center, Cicero
- Maywood Workforce Center
- Received grant later than anticipated

Successes

- C.T.E. faculty assisted in development of curriculum
- ICCB approval of 16-credit career certificate from 13-credit to be eligible as I-CAPS program
- Recruited 12 potential candidates
- Strong internal/external partnerships
- Strong support from Administration and other college programs
