Overview

■ Joint Data Validation:

- ▶ Developed jointly with the Department of Education.
 - Core workgroup representing 3 agencies- Employment and Training Administration (ETA), Office of Career, Technical, and Adult Education (OCTAE), and Rehabilitation Service Administration (RSA)

■ Current Status:

- ▶ In Departmental clearance- clearance/publication anticipated soon.

DV Objectives

- Provide guidelines for developing data validation procedures.
- Meet critical data validation requirements, minimize burden, and achieve common objectives across core programs.
- Outline source documentation on Joint elements- those that are specific to WIOA.
- The source documentation requirements will be the same for all programs- Titles I,II,II and IV.

Source Documentation

- All 3 agencies (ETA, RSA, OCTAE) collaboratively chose which elements to validate on.
- Elements are only those found in the Joint WIOA PIRL, and included in the calculation of primary indicators of performance.

Data Validation Monitoring

- Traditional On-Site Review
 - ▶ Data Validation as component of state comprehensive review
 - ▶ DEV = record review = case file review
- Federal staff revalidate sub-sample of state's sample
 - ▶ Random Sample

Data Validation Monitoring

- Review of Policies, Procedures, Protocols (including training) and how deployed
- Review of Reporting and Validation Process (including MIS)
- Interview Staff
